Uniform Policy

It is important that students wear their uniform with pride: pride in themselves, the way they look and pride in their school. In order to foster a sense of responsibility and formality in our students, we are mandating that every student has a **blazer** (classified as 'formal attire') that is used throughout her High School years. The blazer will be required at the start of the day, as well as for Assemblies, events, excursions and formal occasions.

Terms 2 and 3: Autumn – Winter

Uniform / Sports Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Shirt sleeves must be worn below the elbow ▪ School skirt / sports skirt, must cover the knees when sitting (at all times) ▪ Cross-tie ▪ For Year 12: School Jerseys are permitted, however, must be buttoned up.
Jumper / Coat / Blazer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ V-neck wool sweater / jumper or the new "shell" jacket ▪ Blue / Black puffer coats – may be used when playing outside and travelling to and from school but are not permitted in the classroom. ▪ Blazers must be worn every morning and at Assembly
Shoes & Socks / Tights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Black school shoes ▪ Solid (colour) navy knee-high socks, or navy / black opaque tights ▪ On sports days, leggings are permitted, however should be plain black or navy (i.e. no pattern).
Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plain wristwatch ▪ Piercing: One plain, metallic (non-patterned), small sleeper or stud in each earlobe. No other piercings are permitted other than one item in each lobe. ▪ Hair must be tied up.
Not permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Bracelets ▪ Rings ▪ Make-up ▪ Nail polish ▪ Necklaces ▪ Dyed / streaked hair

Mobile Phones

We discourage the use of mobile phones at School. However, we acknowledge that communication between home and our children is important. To ensure a safe learning environment, all students in the High School are required to "drop off" their phones by 8.20am, to the Drop Box with the High School Secretary, with the exception of Year 12, who are required to leave their phones in the Common Room.

- If a mobile is seen/heard during the day on campus, it will be confiscated for 24 hours and must be collected by a parent.
- If a mobile is seen/heard on a second occasion, it will remain on campus for a full week.
