

# LUGGAGE & PACKING LIST

During the 2023 KTC Israel Experience, the northern hemisphere experiences the beginning of winter. Different parts of Israel have diverse climates and the best way to deal with temperature variations is by layering and a very good jacket/coat.

Avoid bringing any expensive jewellery and keep cash to a minimum – use of a debit/credit card is suggested.

## Suitcases

- Suitcase - which MUST NOT weigh more than 23kg. Any student with two bags at the airport will be required to leave one behind. No student is permitted to pay extra for an additional bag or additional weight.
- Carry-on bag / roll-on for plane – MUST NOT weigh more than 7kg. This bag will come in handy for Bedouin tents, and free Shabbos.
- Smaller backpack to use for hikes or day trips

## Packing List for carry-on for the plane:

- An extra change of clothes, underwear and socks (better safe than sorry)
- Toothbrush and small toothpaste (less than 100ml), personal hygiene products
- Jacket
- Phone – ensure it is unlocked, otherwise the Israeli sim won't work
- Any medication required
- Food, snacks and anything else you will need during your 7 hour stopover in Bangkok
- Chitas / books / reading material / journal
- **Tefillin for boys**
- **Siddur – compulsory for all students to bring a siddur – davening from phone will not be allowed**

## Toiletries in suitcase enough for at least the first 2 weeks:

- Spare toothbrush / Toothpaste
- Hairbrush
- Shampoo / conditioner
- Soap / Deodorant
